CARE OF THE SICK


Emergency calls answered as soon as possible. Communion calls to homebound weekly by request. Please notify the office if someone is homebound.

Dear Parishioners,

Our second graders celebrate their First Eucharist next weekend, April 17 & 18, at all of our regular weekend Masses, including a special 2:00 p.m. Mass on Sunday. We normally fit all of our second graders and their families into one Mass, but that is not possible this year given the guidelines for social distancing. Each family has been surveyed for their first and second choice for which Mass to attend, and we will do our best to make the day special for each child and family.

Unfortunately, the circumstances will not allow for a group photograph this year, or for a reception honoring all of the children at this important moment in their journey of faith. But we will take plenty of individual photos and I am sure the boys and girls will receive many expressions of congratulations from their family and friends.

From its earliest days, the Church has taught and believed in the real presence of Christ in the Eucharist. The visible signs of bread and wine point to a greater reality which is hidden, namely the sacrificial love of Christ by which we are saved and made one with God and others. The Eucharist is a sign of our unity, our oneness with Christ as members of his body. Our reception of Holy Communion nourishes and strengthens our sense of identity as the Body of Christ. We are called to become what we receive in the Eucharist.

This is a great mystery which can be difficult to understand without the gift of faith. And yet even children as young as our second graders can appreciate in their hearts this special gift of Christ to his Church. Their innocence and trust help all of us to reaffirm our faith and reawaken a sense of gratitude for the Eucharist. Please pray for our second graders and their families.

We will honor all of our high school seniors at the 11:00 Mass on Sunday, April 25, and then treat them and their parents to a catered lunch in our Parish Activity Center. We are extremely proud of their accomplishment and wish to assure them of our continued prayers as they plan for the next phase of their life's journey. We ask the graduates or one of their parents to please call the parish office (749-2189) if they can attend so that we can prepare the proper amount of food.

We will be offering a short course on the Sacrament of Confirmation for any adult aged 18 or older who has not yet been confirmed and wishes to receive the sacrament this spring. The course is comprised of four sessions to be held at 6:30 p.m. on the evenings of April 22, 29, May 6, & 20. Those completing the short course will be confirmed on May 30, Trinity Sunday, at the 11:00 a.m. Mass here at St. John the Baptist. Bishop Duca has delegated me, as well as all pastors of the Diocese, to celebrate Confirmation for our adult parishioners this year. 




FOOD PANTRY

ADULT CONFIRMATION


Any adult, 18 years or older, that is interested in being confirmed can attend classes beginning Thursday, April 22nd.


