Emergency calls answered as soon as possible. Communion calls to homebound weekly by request. Please notify the office if someone is homebound.



The dying and rising of Christ was very evident as we celebrated the deepest mysteries of our faith. His death and resurrection are also present in the lives of all believers who have been baptized into this sacred mystery.

Please continue to help welcome our new Catholics who were received into the Church at the Easter Vigil. William Adams, Ireland Adams, Samuel Adams, Madison Laprarie, Kevin Rubio, Trace Trahan, and Hope Zettlemoyer are now one with us at the Eucharistic table. May their enthusiastic reception of their new faith help us to renew our own sense of gratitude in being chosen by God for membership in his family.

I will be off this Wednesday-Thursday, April 20–21, attending a gathering with a few priest friends, so please watch over the parish while I am away. We will have a Communion Service in place of the 8:00 a.m. Mass on Thursday morning in my absence.

We will honor all of our high school seniors at the 11:00 Mass next Sunday, April 24, and then treat them and their parents to lunch in our Parish Activity Center. We are extremely proud of their accomplishment and wish to assure them of our continued prayers as they plan for the next phase of their life's journey. We ask the graduates or one of their parents to please call the parish office (749-2189) if they can attend so that we can prepare the proper amount of food.

We will be offering a short course on the Sacrament of Confirmation for any adult aged 18 or older who has not yet been confirmed and wishes to receive the sacrament this spring. The course is comprised of four sessions to be held at 6:30 p.m. on the evenings of May 5, 19, 26, & June 2. Those completing the short course will be confirmed by Bishop Duca on June 5, Pentecost Sunday, at the 10:30 a.m. Mass at St. Joseph Cathedral. 


