Dear Parishioners,

Congratulations to the new officers of our K.C. Council 10744 who were recently installed at their summer banquet. The Grand Knight is Jerry Eagan and the Deputy Grand Knight is Joey Haydel. Sincere thanks to past Grand Knight Christian Benoit and to all of the officers and knights for their dedicated service to our community and parish.

Our Christian Formation classes are set to resume in two weeks, beginning with the 11th grade Confirmation Class on Sunday, August 15. Therefore, registration for classes is taking place this weekend, July 31 - August 1, immediately following each of our Masses. Our Parent Meeting for all grades is scheduled for Tuesday, August 10, at 6:30 p.m. in the Activity Center. Religion classes for children in grades 1-10 are set to begin on Monday, August 16, Tuesday, August 17, or Wednesday, August 18.

This Friday evening and Saturday morning, August 6 & 7, is the monthly all-night Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament led by our Catholic Daughters. The twelve-hour period begins at 8:00 p.m. Friday evening and ends with 8:00 a.m. Mass on Saturday morning. A schedule is available in the back of church if you would like to sign-up for an hour of prayer and adoration in the presence of our Lord.

We will celebrate the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick next Saturday, August 7, immediately following the 4:30 p.m. Vigil Mass. Any person who is seriously ill because of sickness, old age, or injury may be anointed. The illness may be either physical or mental, and can include addictions. Anointing is also allowed prior to undergoing surgery. Please spread the word to your family and friends who may be in need of the healing graces provided through this special sacrament. And please pray for your fellow parishioners who are hospitalized, homebound, or struggling with cancer or some other serious illness.




