The annual appeal for the Retirement Fund for Religious is this weekend, December 11 & 12. The 7th Annual Nativity Carol, an evening of Advent and Christmas song, is this Sunday, December 12, at 5:00 p.m. in the church. We receive many complements on the singing of our choir and this concert gives us a chance to enjoy their beautiful singing outside of Mass. Admission is free but you are invited to bring a canned good for our food bank. A Christmas Cookie reception will follow in the Parish Activity Center.

Our Advent Penance Service is scheduled for this **Tuesday**, **December 14**, **at 6:00 p.m.** Our second graders will celebrate their 1st Reconciliation at this same service, so we need to support them by our good example. Fathers David Allen, Arun John, Ryan Hallford, and Amrit Raj will be here to assist in this celebration of God's mercy. Four priests will be stationed in the main body of the church, and one priest will be located in the annex for your convenience.

Friday, December 17, is Pope Francis's birthday, so please say a prayer for the continued health and well-being of our Holy Father. He turns 85 this year and remains in very good health despite a demanding schedule. Pope Emeritus Benedict XVI, who retired in 2013 at the age of 85, is now 94 years old.

We will be decorating our church for Christmas next Saturday, December 18, beginning at 9:00 a.m. We need plenty of volunteers so the work can be completed smartly and efficiently. Service hours are available for students, and volunteers are needed to light the trees and hang the garland on the columns. 

The celebration begins on Christmas Eve with a choir concert at 3:15 p.m. followed by a 4:00 p.m. Vigil Mass, and then a second Vigil Mass at 6:00 p.m. Masses on Christmas Day are at 8:00 a.m. and 10:00 a.m. (Please note that with Christmas falling on a Saturday this year, we will not have our regular 4:30 p.m. Saturday afternoon Mass.)
