Dear Parishioners,

The parishioners of Immaculate Conception Parish in Scotlandville have just completed a major renovation of their parish church, similar to the renovation that was completed at St. Margaret Parish in Albany last month, and here in Brusly just over eight years ago. I plan to attend their Mass of rededication which is set for 2:00 p.m. today, Sunday, December 15, 2019.

Immaculate Conception Parish began as a mission of St. Francis Xavier Parish in 1946. Masses were initially celebrated at the Cook Theatre until the completion of their church in 1953. Immaculate Conception then became a separate parish in 1958 to serve the predominately African-American community of north Baton Rouge.

The parish was faithfully served by Josephite priests for many years until it was handed over to the Jesuit priests in 1983. The renovated church has been expanded with the addition of a new foyer, and the interior has been brightened with new flooring and new marble behind the altar. Congratulations to Father Tom Clark, S.J., and the Immaculate Conception Parish community.

The 5th Annual Nativity Carol, an evening of Advent and Christmas song, is also today, Sunday, December 15, at 5:00 p.m. in the church. We receive many complements on the singing of our choir and this concert gives us a chance to enjoy their beautiful singing outside of Mass. Admission is free but you are invited to bring a canned good for our food bank. A Christmas Cookie reception will follow in the Parish Activity Center.

Our Advent Penance Service is scheduled for this **Tuesday**, **December 17**, **at 6:30 p.m.** Our second graders will celebrate their 1st Reconciliation at this same service, so we need to support them by our good example. Fathers David Allen, Chris Decker, Jon Koehler, and Amrit Raj will be here to assist in this celebration of God's mercy. Four priests will be stationed in the main body of the church, and one priest will be located in the annex for your convenience.

We will be decorating our church for Christmas on Monday, December 23, beginning at 9:00 a.m. We need plenty of volunteers so the work can be completed smartly and efficiently. Service hours are available for students, and volunteers are needed to put the trees in the stands and the garland on the columns. John Toups is once again coordinating our decorations so please call or text him at 405-0826 if you have any questions.

Our schedule of services for Christmas includes two Masses on Christmas Eve and two Masses on Christmas morning. The celebration begins on Christmas Eve with a choir concert at 3:15 p.m. followed by a 4:00 p.m. Vigil Mass, and then a second Vigil Mass at 6:00 p.m. Masses on Christmas Day are at 8:00 a.m. and 10:00 a.m.. (We do not have a midnight Mass but there is one right next door at St. John the Evangelist in Plaquemine.)

Congratulations to the LSU Tigers for winning the SEC championship and being selected No. 1 by the College Football Playoff selection committee. They will now play No. 4 Oklahoma in the Chick-fil-A Peach Bowl on December 28 for a chance to advance to the championship game.


