Dear Parishioners,

Ash Wednesday is one of the most important days of the year for Catholics even though it is not a holy day of obligation. God touches our hearts in a special way as we enter into the grace-filled season of Lent, so please try to attend Mass either here or elsewhere this Wednesday. Masses here on **Ash Wednesday** will be at 8:00 a.m., 12:00 noon, and 6:00 p.m. Daily Mass remains at the normal time of 8:00 a.m. on Tuesday, Thursday, and Friday, but moves to 6:00 p.m. on the Wednesdays of Lent. Benediction and Adoration remains at 8:30 a.m. on Friday mornings or immediately following the Friday morning Mass.

On the **Wednesdays of Lent**, confessions are at 5:30 p.m., followed by Mass at 6:00 p.m. and then the Way of the Cross at 6:30 p.m. I will also be in the confessional from 6:30 p.m. – 7:30 p.m. each Wednesday as part of the "Light is On for You" program. I encourage everyone to try to attend at least one daily Mass each week as part of your Lenten devotions.

The K.C.'s have their annual spaghetti dinner fundraiser next Sunday, March 1, from 11:00 a.m. -1:00 p.m., and are selling tickets after all of our Masses this weekend. Please give them your support.

Bishop Michael Duca has designated March 8, 2020, the 2<sup>nd</sup> Sunday of Lent, as "Safe Haven Sunday" in the Diocese of Baton Rouge. "Safe Haven Sunday" is a national program designed to help families safeguard their homes from pornography and other online threats. The inappropriate use of technology poses a very serious threat to the sanctity of marriages and families in today's world. Please pray for the success of this effort so that all of our homes can truly become "safe havens."


