Emergency calls answered as soon as possible. Communion calls to homebound weekly by request. Please notify the office if someone is homebound.



Dear Parishioners,

Pope Francis has invited Catholics around the world to participate in a synodal process designed to help the Church grow in the areas of "Communion, Participation, and Mission." Bishop Duca released a letter on the Third Sunday of Advent outlining our response to the Pope's appeal here in the Diocese of Baton Rouge.

A series of dialogue sessions have now been scheduled in every region of the Diocese. One for our area is scheduled for next Saturday, January 29, from 9:00 – 11:00 a.m. at Holy Family Church in Port Allen. Discussion questions include, "In what ways has the local Church of Baton Rouge and/or your parish been successful in bringing people together in communion?" "Which groups and individuals are least included in our diocese and/or your parish?" "Where is the Holy Spirit calling the Church to mission and service today?"

All are invited to attend the dialogue session next Saturday at Holy Family, or one of the later sessions held elsewhere. Another one is scheduled for Wednesday, February 16, from 6:00-8:00 p.m. in St. John the Evangelist Parish Hall in Plaquemine. Catholics unable to attend one of the sessions will also be provided with an opportunity to submit their feedback online.

National Catholic Schools Week is the annual celebration of Catholic education in the United States. It runs from January 30 – February 5, 2022, and this year's theme is "Catholic Schools: Faith. Excellence. Service." There are 5,981 Catholic Schools in the United States, of which 4,812 are elementary and 1,169 are secondary schools. Our own Diocese of Baton Rouge has 22 Catholic elementary schools and 8 Catholic high schools.

Although we do not have our own parish school we are blessed to have Catholic schools on either side of us at Holy Family and St. John the Evangelist. Holy Family School in Port Allen has its Open House on Thursday, February 3, from 9:00 a.m. – 2:00 p.m., and St. John Interparochial School in Plaquemine has its Open House on the same day, Thursday, February 3. (Please call the school for times.)

The men of our parish are invited to attend the Catholic Men's Conference to be held on Saturday, March 5, 2022, at St. George Church in Baton Rouge, beginning at 7:30 a.m. and ending at 3:00 p.m. This year's speakers include Dr. Brant Pitre, Super Bowl Champ Harrison Butker, Chef John Folse, and Father Todd Lloyd. 




