Dear Parishioners,

I mentioned at the end of Mass a couple of weeks ago that we are in need of additional catechists to help teach religion to our children, as well as additional liturgical ministers to serve at our Masses, so please give some thought to signing up for one of these important ministries.

Parents are the primary teachers of their children in matters of faith, and they do so by modeling prayer and Christian living. However, children also benefit from learning more about their faith in discussion with their peers under the guidance of a caring adult. Catechists often discover that their own faith is nourished through the process of sharing it with these young disciples. So please call our Christian Formation Office for more information or to sign up.

As more and more parishioners return to Sunday Mass, we find ourselves in need of additional altar servers and ushers. I have scheduled a training session for new altar servers on Tuesday, July 20, at 5:00 p.m., and new ushers at 6:00 p.m. that same evening in the church. (It is not necessary for current liturgical ministers to attend the training unless you are unsure of the procedures and wish to review them.)

I especially encourage our 5th, 6th, and 7th graders to consider becoming altar servers. Adults are eligible to serve in all of the various liturgical ministries but altar serving is the one ministry that is especially suited to children and teenagers. Our Masses are more enjoyable and meaningful when all age groups are visibly involved in ministry.

Altar serving also allows our young parishioners to become familiar with the candles and communion vessels, and to be physically near the altar during the celebration of the Mass. They learn to handle sacred objects and to grow in love and reverence for the Eucharist.

The ministry of usher is open to both men and women, single and married, so please feel free to sign up for this ministry of hospitality. Ushers welcome Catholics to church, direct newcomers to the restrooms and cry room, and assist parishioners in finding a seat as the pews fill up. They also pass the collection baskets and invite families to bring up the gifts in the offertory procession. Families are often chosen according to the Mass intentions for each Mass.

Please remember that Vacation Bible School is this week from 9:00 a.m. -12:00 noon, Monday through Friday, in the activity center and classrooms. Please watch out for the children and be extra careful in the parking lot during drop off and pick up. I know the kids will have a great time getting together with their friends and classmates for a fun week of activities. Thank you to all of our volunteers who give so generously of their time to make VBS a success.

The Baptismal Seminar scheduled for Wednesday evening, July 14, at 6:00 p.m., will be held in room 2 in the Parish Activity Center instead of classroom 5 due to Vacation Bible School.




