Dear Parishioners,

The Catholic writer and editor Elizabeth Scalia observed: "Some years we approach our Lenten disciplines with a sense of enthusiasm; we're ready for the challenges of the desert; we know we will emerge stronger for our time spent thirsting, climbing, and stepping forward in faith. In other years, we may look at Lent with wary eyes, all too familiar with the weight of our faults, and daunted by the bright empty heat into which we must carry them, until we find Jesus, to whom they may be surrendered."

I can relate to both sentiments - enthusiasm and wariness - as we enter into this grace-filled season of Lent. I am attracted to the possibility of spiritual and personal growth through the paring down of so many unnecessary distractions and practices which creep into my life. I look forward to the simplicity of the desert, and more time spent with Christ and friends. At the same time, I realize the effort involved in naming my faults and surrendering them to Christ.

Daily Mass during Lent remains at the normal time of 8:00 a.m. on Tuesday, Thursday, and Friday, but moves to 6:00 p.m. each Wednesday. On the **Wednesdays of Lent**, confessions are at 5:30 p.m., followed by Mass at 6:00 p.m. and then the Way of the Cross at 6:30 p.m. I will also hear confessions from 6:30 p.m. – 7:30 p.m. each Wednesday as part of the "Light is On for You" program.

All of our 9<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup> grade students are invited to church this Tuesday evening, March 8, beginning at 7:00 p.m. for adoration of the Blessed Sacrament and the opportunity for confession. Our 8<sup>th</sup> graders will join us in church on Wednesday night this week, March 9, for the Way of the Cross and the opportunity for confession.

Bishop Michael Duca has designated next Sunday, March 13, as "Safe Haven Sunday – Year 3." "Safe Haven Sunday" is a national program designed to help families safeguard their homes from pornography and other online threats. The parent book for Year 3 is entitled "Connected – How Strong Family Relationships Lead to Internet-Safe Kids," and can be downloaded by texting SECURE to 66866. A few hard copies are also available in church. Please pray for the success of this effort so that all of our homes can become "safe havens."

In addition to their fall pro-life campaign, "40 Days for Life" also sponsors a spring campaign which runs from March 2 through April 10, 2022. Our parish has adopted Saturday, March 19, the Feast of St. Joseph, from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. to offer prayer and peaceful witness outside of the Delta Clinic on Colonial Drive in Baton Rouge. No sign up is required.

The K.C.'s have their annual spaghetti dinner fundraiser this Sunday, March 6, from 11:00 a.m. – 1:00 p.m., so please give them your support.

Daylight Saving Time starts next Sunday, March 13, so remember to move your clocks ahead by one hour before going to bed next Saturday night.




