Dear Parishioners,

Please welcome Father Raju Macherla who is visiting our parish to make an appeal on behalf of the *Diocese of Warangal* located in the south Indian state of Telangana. Father Macherla's visit is coordinated by our Diocesan Propagation of the Faith Office and provides an opportunity for us to support the pastoral ministry and missionary activity of the Church. A second collection basket labeled *Mission Appeal* is located by the baptismal font in church.

We rejoice that our local Church now has three more priests to celebrate Mass and the sacraments for the people of our Diocese. Father David Dawson, Father Danny Roussel, and Father Taylor Sanford were ordained this weekend by Bishop Michael Duca.

Father Dawson, age 47, worked as a perfusionist at the Baton Rouge General before entering the seminary. He has been assigned to St. George Parish in Baton Rouge for his first parish assignment. Father Roussel, age 49, worked as a quality control manager at PepsiCo prior to entering the seminary, and has been assigned to St. Aloysius Parish in Baton Rouge. Father Sanford, age 29, is an LSU engineering graduate and has been assigned to Immaculate Conception in Denham Springs for his first assignment. All assignments are effective July 1.

Father David Allen, pastor of our neighboring parish of Holy Family in Port Allen, is retiring at the end of June. Father David was ordained in 1978 and has thus provided 43 years of priestly service to the Diocese of Baton Rouge. As announced earlier this month, the new pastor of Holy Family will be Father Ryan Hallford, currently serving as parochial vicar of St. Aloysius Parish. Father Ryan, age 37, was ordained in 2017 and spent his first year of priesthood at Holy Family Parish with Father David. We welcome Father Ryan back to the westside.

Vacation Bible School will be split between two weeks this year, July 12-16 and July 19-23, so we can safely accommodate all of the children who wish to attend. Up to 70 participants will be allowed each week, so mark your calendars and come enjoy a week's activities with classmates and friends. We need teachers and aides as well as participants so all are invited to join us. We are making preliminary plans to hold the "Cards, Etc. Party" on Monday, October 11, and the "Feast on the Levee" on Sunday, October 24, 2021. However, our ability to host these two popular community gatherings is contingent on our ability to prevent another spike in the spread of the coronavirus. I continue to encourage all parishioners to get vaccinated so we can more safely socialize and come together for fellowship and Sunday Mass.

We will have a Communion Service in place of the 8:00 a.m. Mass this Wednesday, May 26, so I can attend a funeral for a relative in north Louisiana.






