Dear Parishioners,

November 5-11 is National Vocation Awareness Week for Catholics in the United States. In a recent letter, Pope Francis wrote, "I ask parish communities, associations and the many prayer groups present in the Church, not to yield to discouragement but to continue praying that the Lord will send workers to his harvest. May he give us priests enamored of the Gospel, close to all their brothers and sisters, living signs of God's merciful love." In honor of the upcoming Veterans Day we are planning to honor all of our veterans at our 9:00 a.m. Mass next Sunday, November 12, 2017. The ongoing conflicts around the world have served as a necessary reminder of the debt we owe to our service men and women who work to build peace and protect our country from terrorism. All veterans and their families are invited to attend the Mass so that we can offer our prayers and gratitude.
