Dear Parishioners,

Today is designated as Respect Life Sunday, and the month of October as Respect Life Month. This year's theme is "Christ Our Hope: In Every Season of Life." Our faith encourages us to aim high in our work on behalf of life. Pope Benedict XVI wrote, "If we cannot hope for more than is effectively attainable at any given time, or more than is promised by political or economic authorities, our lives will soon be without hope" (*Spe Salvi 35*). I pray that our prayer and witness on behalf of life may produce changes in belief and practice within our lifetime.

The priests of the Baton Rouge Diocese have our annual retreat this week of October 7-11 at Manresa Retreat House in Convent. Our retreat director is Bishop Shelton Fabre, formerly a priest of the Diocese of Baton Rouge and now Bishop of the Diocese of Houma-Thibodaux. The theme for this year's retreat is "Called by God."

Bishop Fabre is a native of New Roads, Louisiana and attended St. Joseph Seminary College near Covington, and the American Seminary in Louvain, Belgium, prior to his ordination in 1989. He served as pastor of St. Joseph Parish in Grosse Tete, Immaculate Heart of Mary Parish in Maringouin, and Sacred Heart Parish in Baton Rouge before being named an auxiliary bishop of New Orleans in 2007. He has served as the Bishop of Houma-Thibodaux since 2013.


